




# **Ongoing Popularity**




# Time Spent on the Course





#### Time Required to Complete Course






Poll: What percentage of learners contacted Tech Support?

**Quality of Tech Support** 




Likelihood of Taking another eLearning Course at THTC


#### Likelihood of Taking another eLearning Course at THTC




### Likelihood of Recommendation
